- ·Walk-in closets with built-ins
- ·Mudroom
- ·Very spacious laundry room
- ·Garage with built in storage areas

Exterior Staging

Creating Excellent Curb Appeal

- ·Close garage doors
- •Remove all cars, boats, RV's, motorcycles, etc. from the driveway and do not park in front of house
- Move garbage and recycling cans out of sight
- •Remove all garden tools, hoses, and clutter
- •Blow off driveway, sidewalks, and patio areas
- •Turn on front porch light
- ·Clean/wash all windows
- Power wash driveway and sidewalk



Deck/ Backyard

- •Power wash deck
- ·Open patio umbrella
- Uncover grill (if nice)
- ·Place beverages on patio table
- ·Use container plants to add color and style



- •Pitcher of tea and glasses
- ·Cocktails
- •Fresh flowers on patio table

Landscaping

- ·Mow the grass, rake up leaves and debris, pull weeds and remove any dead vegetation Install fresh pine straw or mulch
- •Prune trees and shrubs
- Plant blooming flowers
- •Remove empty plant containers
- ·Clear out kids toys, balls, frisbees, etc.



Swimming Pools and Spas

- ·Vacuum and skim pool water
- •Remove pool and spa covers
- •Remove sweepers and pool toys
- ·Straighten lounge chairs
- ·Open patio umbrella
- •Turn on pool lights and any water features
- •Turn on spa bubbles



Interior

- ·Replace all burned out bulbs
- ·Remove excess furniture
- •Turn on all lights
- •Pick up rugs and runners in entryways, kitchens and bathroom (unless exceptionally nice)





- Wash windows
- ·Vacuum and mop floors
- •Remove soap scum from bathrooms
- •Remove dust and cobb webs
- Open all blinds and curtains
- •Turn off and clean ceiling fans
- ·Turn off TVs

Kitchen


- ·Clear counters but leave a few appliances
- ·Clear refrigerator of magnets, photos, menus, etc
- ·Clean and polish appliances
- •Remove any dishtowels that aren't decorative
- ·No dishes



- ·Fresh fruit basket
- ·Vase with cut flowers
- •Fresh vegetables on chopping board
- Beverages on serving tray

Dining Room


- •Dust furniture and vacuum floors
- •Set the table with nice dinnerware
- ·Add centerpiece to table
- •Straighten china cabinet or buffet
- ·Straighten chairs and space evenly
- ·Remove child seats/booster



- ·Candle holder with candle
- ·Vase with cut flowers
- •Fresh vegetables on chopping board
- •Set table china, silver, stemware, placemats, table runner

Bathrooms


- ·Clean mirrors
- ·Remove soap scum
- ·Lower toilet seats
- •Remove bathroom accessories from counters
- •Remove soaps and shampoos from shower
- •Remove bath towels unless decorative



- ·Vase with flowers
- ·Candles
- Fancy soaps
- Apothecary jars
- •Fluffy white bathrobe

Living & Family Room

- Dust and vacuum well
- ·Wash glass surfaces and remove smudges (these show in photos)
- ·Straighten pillows and throws
- Declutter fireplace mantel
- •Remove newspapers and books
- •Tuck away remote controls
- ·Conceal cables the best you can
- •Remove personal photos and toys



- •Decorative pillows and throws
- ·Candles

Bedrooms

- Make beds and straighten bedspread and pillows
- ·Tidy up, dust, and vacuum
- ·Put away clothes, shoes, blankets
- •Remove items from bedside tables (books, magazines, pictures, clock, etc.)
- •Put away excess toys and take down posters



- •Decorative pillows and throws
- ·Candles
- ·Reading books
- •Throws
